

## **SOTERIA Visiting Fellowship positions for Ukrainian researchers**

### **Maastricht University, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASoS)**

#### **Eligibility requirements:**

This opportunity is open to Ukrainian citizens and residents directly or indirectly affected by the war. Applicants can be PhD students, early career researchers or experienced researchers.

Your research interests would align with what we do at FASoS. FASoS research is characterized by interdisciplinarity within and across the humanities and social sciences, including history, cultural studies, literature, political science, philosophy and anthropology.

#### **What FASoS offers:**

- (Shared) office space, including access to a computer, telephone, and email-account.
- Access to the university library.
- Integration into the research environment of FASoS, including the offer to participate in research colloquia and seminars.
- Fellowships are between 3-12 months, depending on the specific research plans of the applicant.
- This is an unpaid position. Financial support for the research fellow is available (please see further information below).

#### **What we do:**

Our research institute studies societies and cultures as they unfolded during the modern and contemporary era in a radically interdisciplinary manner. We analyse the interrelationships of Europeanisation, globalisation, scientific and technological development, political change and cultural innovation. Our research starts from today's problems, but we have a strong interest in how the modern world came to be.
